Submission Guidelines

The Association for Character Education publishes material relating to best practice in character education both in the United Kingdom and abroad. Our bulletin 'Character Matters' is published three times per year and caters to a wide audience.

Beside our core team of contributors we run a series of supplements with each addition. These are themed around particular areas of character education.

General submissions

We welcome unsolicited articles. You can expect to hear a decision within three months of submission. These will be considered for publication in our bulletin. It is, however, recommended that you make initial contact with us before this. Submission of a query with an outline of 50-100 words allows us to comment on an article's suitability. Articles should be original and not under consideration elsewhere. Articles should be between 1500 and 3000 words including footnotes. Please be aware we can receive many queries and articles so do allow time for a response.

How to submit

Articles should be submitted in electronic form, text only and in MS Word. We expect authors to thoroughly check any facts before submission.

Rights

We ask all authors of articles we publish to agree to our use of the article on our website and through our e-Journal. This can, though may not, include references made in summary emails sent out to ACE members. As our publication is in its infancy, and we are not a profit-making publication, we cannot currently pay authors for their articles. Therefore we accept authors may wish to republish an article following publication in Character Matters as long as acknowledgement is made.
